FAITH PROMISE

What is Faith Promise?

It is giving something you don't have.

Faith Promise Commitments are made once a year at your “*Heart for Missions Sunday*”. Although our churches love missions and Church Planting year-round, this is a special time when we focus and spotlight these 2 very important ministries.

A ‘Faith Promise’ commitment card is given to every person with the hope that they have in prayer been asking God for the amount that He would have them to give toward Missions and Church Planting during the coming year. It is important to understand that (a) ‘Faith Promise’ funds will only be used outside the local church, and (b) That it is to be given by faith. (It is not based on what you have to give now or might have to give in the future.)

1. Faith Promise is just that — Promises made by Faith

It is giving something you don't have.

Brothers and Sisters of a local church give a certain amount of money to the mission's program of the church. It may be designated weekly, monthly or a one-time gift.



2. The Emphasis is on Faith in Making these Commitments

Believers in prayer ask the Lord how much they should give and trust Him to supply the extra needed funds. The “*Faith Promise Offering*” is given in addition to the regular tithe.

3. You will Not Be Asked for the Amount you Designate

The ‘*Faith Promise Offering*’ is a commitment between you and the Lord. The commitment cards do not have a member’s name on.

4. The Faith Promise Cards Enable Wise Budgeting

The Church’s Financial officers and Missions team have the duty of budgeting and distributing mission funds. These cards help to plan Missions commitments and projects for the coming year.

5. God will Honor your Faith Commitment!

He may increase your income. He may give you wisdom to cut back on unnecessary areas of your family expenses. He may give you extra unexpected income. Whatever your gift, God honors faithfulness. Truly, we can never out-give God.

HOW TO PROCEED!

1. Begin with a week of Prayer and several messages on Missions and Church Planting.
 - During the weekly services “Faith Promise” cards may be preliminary distributed.
 - An advanced distribution gives your people a chance to get acquainted with it and focus prayerfully on what the Lord may want them to do.
2. The week ends with a “Faith Promise” Sunday. On that Sunday a “Faith Promise” commitment card is given to every person. The “*Faith Promise*” Cards are presented to all attendees at the beginning of the service.
3. Then the cards are collected at a special prayerful time directly after the message.
 - Suggestion: Ask members to personally come forward and deposit their “Faith Promise” card in a basket on the church altar.
 - Possibly Palm Sunday may be a splendid time to designate as “Missions Sunday” in your church.
4. Help the people understand that on “*Faith Promise*” Sunday no monies will be collected.
 - On “*Faith Promise*” Sunday you will collect only the “*Faith Promise*” Cards but **NO** monies
5. *Each Sunday following make clear that “Faith Promise” Offerings are to be deposited in a separate basket marked “Missions & Church Planting”.*
 - *Repeat these instructions weekly until your congregation is well oriented.*

The Faith Promise Plan

WHAT IT IS NOT!

- It is not a pledge. Ecc. 5:4-5
- It is not something that someone will come to collect. 2 Cor. 8:12
- It is not something you calculate to determine how much you can give.
- It is not taken away from what you already give to the church through Tithes & offerings.

WHAT IT IS!

- It is a promise between you and God. 2 Cor. 8:12
- It is waiting upon God to tell you how much He wants you to give for reaching the world for Christ. Phil 2:13
- You must trust Him to supply it. 2 Cor. 9:7-8
- You and the missionary become partners in faith. Both must trust the Lord. Rom. 1:17

Faith Promise Missionary and Church Planting Giving

A FAITH PROMISE is a financial commitment to missions and church planting based upon an inner persuasion that God wants you to give that amount to missions, an amount not dependent upon known or anticipated resources.

FAITH PROMISE GIVING challenges us to trust God by basing our giving not on what we can give on our own, but on what God will give extra through us.

IT IS SCRIPTURAL. 2 Corinthians 8 and 9 describe missionary giving in the early church. Paul writes, “Going to the limit of their resources ... and even beyond that limit, they begged to be allowed to share.” (2 Co. 8: 3-4)

IT IS NOT THE TITHE. Tithes already belong to God. Tithes support our own church. Faith promise giving goes beyond your regular giving. Faith promise giving is not for our own local church. It supports our missionaries and church planters.

Faith promise giving is extra giving. It is sacrificially giving above what you think you can afford in order to help others know and experience God through faith in Jesus Christ.

By Faith you expect God to give you something extra this year, which you will then share with our missionaries and church planters.

IT IS NOT A PLEDGE. A pledge is horizontal, promised by the donor to a worthy cause. By contrast, a faith promise is vertical, between you and God.

You will not be asked for your donation.

FOUR IMPORTANT POINTS

1. What Is Registered On “Faith Promise” Cards?

Your amount of financial commitment to missions and church planting for the coming year.

2. How Is My Faith Promises Designated?

Your entire Faith Promise is designated outside of our local church’s budget for the support of missionaries and church planters.

3. Is My Tithe Used To Support Missionaries?

No. Your Faith Promise is above your regular giving.

You promise by faith is to trust God for something extra.

Only your extra *Faith promise* offerings are specifically designated to support our missionaries and church planters.

4. How Are Faith Promises Paid?

Gifts may be paid monthly, weekly, or for a lump sum at any time.

Be sure to mark them separately from your regular giving.

THREE DRAMATIC RESULTS

1. Providential Supply

God's abundant resources are released in unexpected ways above and beyond what we expect.

2. Contagious Giving

By sharing in the faith promise ingathering, you are part of a growing movement of outreach in our church.

3. God's Abundant Blessing

Sharing the love of Jesus with the world, which is our primary purpose, brings God's abundant blessing both financially and spiritually.
