Discussion time (Part I): approx. 30 min. Discussion time (Part II): approx. 30 min. Discussion time (Part III): approx. 30 min.

Lecture instructions

- Break up the lecture into 3 parts.
- Divide men and women into separate Small Groups for Discussion Times.
- Lead 4 Discussion times.

Leader's Oral Opening Comments

This lecture gives us a glimpse of Jesus' heart. Growing individuals for God even as He grew Peter, James, and John.

Leader's Oral Closing Comments

After feeding the multitude Jesus had lots of food left over. It seems to me that even after prolonged discussion and intensive prayer there will be lots of "food" left over to meditate on at home.

Discussion instructions

- ▶ Lead the practical interaction parts discussions in 4 separate sessions.
 - 1. Following the section called "II. Seventeen Spiritual Benefits of Training Faithful Men thus before the section called "III. Eight Requirements To Be An Effective Trainer Of Men" lead your attendees to discuss the questions in Part I (questions 1-10) in their groups.
 - 2. Following the section called "V. *Our Goal*," thus before the section called "VI. *How To Begin Training Faithful Men*" lead your men to discuss the questions in Part II (questions 11-23) in their groups.
 - After they have discussed those questions, hand out the supplementary *Project Sheets*. Explain that they will not need to fill in any of the blanks at this time. They will be explained during the remaining part of the lecture and may be referred to at that time. Later, when the participants return to their own places of ministry, they will photocopy and use these sheets to disciple other individuals.
 - 3. After the end of the lecture have your students discuss the questions in Part III (questions 24-34) in their Small Groups.
 - 4. Then come together in a large group to review, discuss, interact with, and then instruct accurately the sequential use of the Project Sheets question 35.

Prayer instructions

- Specific prayer parts from the Outline are provided under 7SM.
- Dbserve the State of your "flock" (The Bible says). Observe your attendees where they are at in regard to mentoring. Are they ready to begin? Have they already implemented parts?
- > Several parts of the Outline each form a separate section from which you could lead a prayer time by calling out and explaining/modifying/emphasizing certain elements.
- Each of these parts focuses on different needs.
- > To meet needs divide up into random size small groups which fit around one topic and provide them with that specific topic from the Outline for their prayer time.

Pass-out material — instructions

- > Pass out the questions to your Small Group Leaders.
- Pass out The Project Sheets to all participants.
- For prayer print and use parts of the Outline as needed by Prayer Group leaders.
- Pass out the Practical Assignment to all present.
